We believe they would not be possible without strong leadership. That is why we have been facilitating a community leadership program for 27 years. Ask around – you are likely to discover many adults and youth in government, business, healthcare, education or justice systems who have participated in Leadership Livingston. We immerse participants in community issues over a span of 8 months. We introduce participants to county leaders not only to help develop skills, but also to learn how to keep this county so desirable. We are the leaders of Leadership Livingston.

Our program is different from other leadership workshops. Participants start in October learning about leadership through the lens of their experiences. Traveling around the county from month to month, they interact with community leaders from diverse sectors. They practice strategy and collaboration with participating local nonprofit boards. After learning and working this way, our May graduates launch as community trustees, board members, public servants, or business leaders, and as life-long friends.
