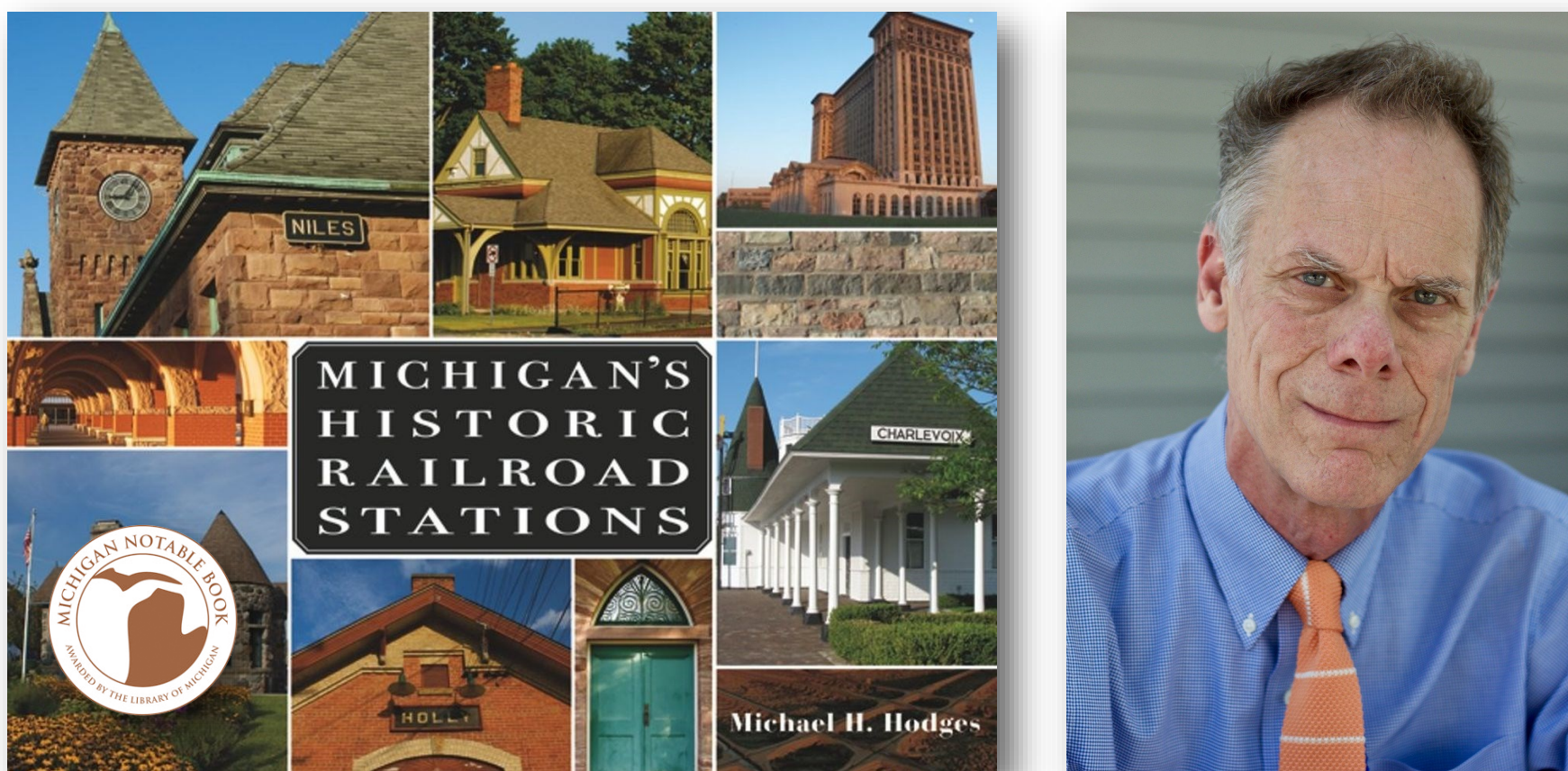


# MICHIGAN'S HISTORIC RAILROAD STATIONS
