NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) Water Resources Division (WRD) will hold a public hearing at the Three Fires Elementary School, 4125 Crooked Lake Road, Howell, Michigan 48843, in the cafeteria, August 12, 2021, at 6:00pm.

This hearing can be attended in person at the above stated location or can be joined online.

The purpose of this hearing is to secure the views of interested persons concerning the following application for permit:

Application for permit HNW-YFKN-4HT87 under Part 303, Wetlands Protection, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), by Mr. Craig Schrottenboer, 117 W. 7TH Street, Holland, Michigan 49423. The applicant proposes to fill approximately 0.85 acre of emergent wetland to construct a car shredding facility. The proposed project will also include replacement of two 37-foot long, 48-inch diameter culverts with two 72-foot long, 48-inch diameter culverts to facilitate widening of an access road through wetland and construction of a sediment basin in upland with an Aquip Filtration System and outlets discharging to wetland. The applicant proposes to provide compensatory wetland mitigation by purchasing wetland bank credits. The project is located on Lucy Road in T02N, R05E, Section 06, City of Howell, Livingston County, Michigan.

Any written comments to be submitted for the public hearing record must be received at this address on or before the close of the record.

The hearing will be held pursuant to Section 30307 of Part 303 of the NREPA. The hearing will not be a legal proceeding, witnesses will not be sworn, and there will be no cross examination. Public hearings are primarily informational and are held to encourage the expression of views and presentation of facts.

The EGLE will, upon written request, provide a copy of the EGLE's decision on this application.
