Livingston County Health Department Now Scheduling COVID-19 Vaccinations for Children Ages 5-11

HOWELL, Michigan. - (November 3, 2021) Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) is now scheduling free Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 5-11. This announcement follows the recent [FDA authorization](#) and [CDC recommendation](#) of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccination for children in this age group. The COVID-19 vaccine is widely available locally, and parents or guardians should go wherever works best for their family. COVID-19 vaccines are available from local primary care providers, pharmacies, and pediatrician offices. LCHD recommends individuals use www.vaccines.gov to find a convenient vaccination location.

Children ages 5-11 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the time of vaccination. Only one adult should accompany the minor to the appointment due to space limitations. To schedule a COVID-19 vaccination appointment with LCHD, eligible individuals can visit <https://bit.ly/3GQXkOL>.
