

BRIGHTON ARTS AND CULTURE COMMISSION CALL TO ARTISTS OUTDOOR WALL MURAL FOR THE ST. PAUL POCKET PARK

The City of Brighton Arts and Culture Commission (BACC) is seeking proposals from artists for a mural on an outdoor retaining wall of St. Paul Pocket Park, with a target completion date of October 1, 2024.





Project Details:

The BACC is seeking submission of proposals for the design of an outdoor wall mural that the artist will install by approximately October 1, 2024, in the St. Paul Street "pocket park." Designed as a vibrant gathering space fostering creativity and social interaction, the mural will represent the community, areas of artistic creativity and movement. The mural will enhance a winding thorocoat wall spanning approximately 170 feet in length. Its height varies from 3 to 4.5 feet, with sections near ground level at each end. Please see the map, photos, and sketches of the wall below for reference. There is also a link on the last page of this document that contains larger images of the blank sketches below. All applications and materials for this project are due August 22, 2024.




Arial Map:

Application and Project Timeline:

- Application period opens: July 22, 2024
- Deadline for submissions: August 22, 2024
- Submissions are reviewed by the City of Brighton Arts and Culture Commissioners: If you
 are selected as a potential muralist for the project, you will be contacted to confirm your
 interest, availability and pricing.
- Recommendation of artist selection to City Council: August 27, 2024
- Artist notified of selection: August 28, 2024
- Artist begins painting the mural: Any time after August 30, 2024
- Project completion: Approximately October 1, 2024

Location:

St. Paul Pocket Park (at the corner of W. Grand River and St. Paul Street)

Budget:

Up to \$8,000 will be awarded to the selected applicant. This amount is all inclusive, and encompasses all fees associated with the project such as artist salary, equipment, travel, and installation costs.

Eligibility Requirements:

All applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible for selection.

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be capable of both designing and painting the mural
- Must complete and submit an application to be considered. An artist statement, three
 photos of art projects, and all images of the rendering must be attached to the
 application page, which is to be emailed to millerm@brightoncity.org as a PDF.



The Selection Process:

All applications will be reviewed by the Brighton Arts and Culture Commission, who will choose a recommended finalist via jury selection. The selection will be presented to Brighton City Council who will approve the design of the mural.
