

RESOLUTION NO. 21-22
ACCEPTANCE AND APPROVAL OF A JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER FROM
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON TO
THE CITY OF HOWELL OF LUCY ROAD, INDUSTRIAL STREET AND A
PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD D-19

WHEREAS, the City of Howell has requested the transfers of Lucy Road, from the Grand River BL-96 intersection to its Southern limits, Industrial Street, from the Lucy Road intersection to the street's eastern limit, and a portion of County Road D-19 at and near the westbound entry and exit ramps to west I-96, and;

WHEREAS, these requested transfers will provide an equal level of road service and sanitary sewer and municipal water services, within the City's jurisdictional boundaries, to the property owners within the City. In addition, there are opportunities and benefits for potential pavement improvements, for development of certain properties, both within and without the City, along Lucy Road. Such a transfer will create new jobs during these developments and improve the City's tax base, and;

WHEREAS, the Livingston County Road Commission has offered to transfer jurisdiction of Lucy Road, from the Grand River BL-96 intersection to its Southern limits, Industrial Street, from the Lucy Road intersection to the street's eastern limit, and a portion of County Road D-19 at and near the westbound entry and exit ramps to west I-96, to the City, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Livingston has relinquished jurisdiction of Lucy Road, Industrial Street and a portion of County Road D-19 to the City of Howell, effective October 14, 2021, under Road Commission Resolution 2110-082.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Howell City Council hereby **ACCEPTS AND APPROVES** the jurisdictional transfer of Lucy Road, Industrial Street and a portion of County Road D-19 as described in Road Commission Resolution 2110-082, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference to this Resolution 21-22, as Exhibit A.
